



My ScriptRewards Program Offering Additional Benefits For Your Patients Taking HIV Medications.

As health care and prescription medication costs continue to rise, UnitedHealthcare® is working to help ease the burden. Our new program, My ScriptRewards, provides your eligible patients with additional benefits if they fill certain lower-cost treatment regimens of HIV medications. It is included in their pharmacy benefit.

An easy way to save.

My ScriptRewards lets patients fill certain medication treatment combinations at a \$0 cost-share. Additionally, if your patient fills one of these regimens, they will receive a \$250 prepaid debit card for medical expenses every six months, as long as they continue filling their prescription and the program is available.

Prescriptions for \$0

Work with your patient to determine if the available \$0 cost-share option regimens are right for them. These treatment combinations are available at \$0 cost-share no matter the patient's plan benefit design (e.g. high deductible, coinsurance, copay).

Getting started with My ScriptRewards.

After your patient fills their \$0 cost-share option regimen, they are eligible to activate their additional benefit.

Patients must go to myscriptrewards.com to sign up



The patient will need to enter their name, email, birth date, member ID (from their health plan ID card), and the address where they would like their medical debit card delivered.



The patient will receive an email confirming the successful submission of their information, and within a few weeks a second email with an update about their program eligibility.



If the patient is eligible, they should receive their first \$250 prepaid medical debit card within one month of activation.



If the patient continues to fill the \$0 cost options, they'll receive their second \$250 prepaid medical debit card six months later, as long as the program is still in place.

The prepaid debit cards are restricted and can only be used for health care expenses such as lab fees, office copays, or other prescriptions.

If you and your patient decide that the eligible \$0 cost-share regimens aren't right for them, use myuhc.com or call 1-877-636-9712 (TTY: 711) to learn about covered options under the patient's pharmacy benefit.
